SIGUCCS is part of the Association for Computing Machinery, the world's largest educational and scientific computing society.



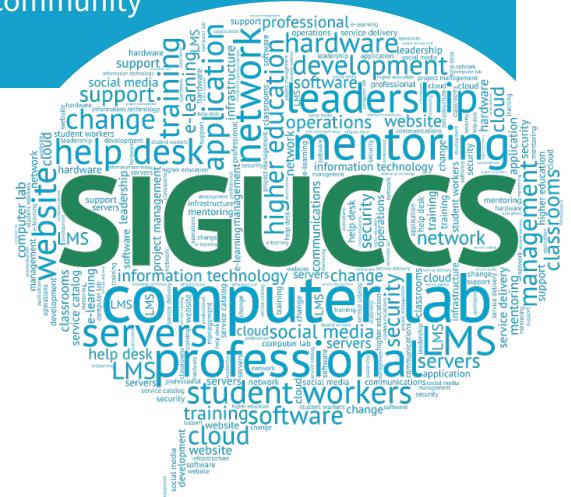
Members of SIGUCCS have opportunities to present, publish, and receive awards for their work at our annual conference.
